Background & About Us

Open Newtown is the public facing name of the *Going Green for a Living Community Land Trust Ltd*. Recently formed (2017), we are all about unlocking our green spaces to create opportunities for enterprise, activities, food, events, health & wellbeing, and energy projects whilst improving biodiversity.

Our starting point was the 2015 Community Led Action Plan drawn up by Newtown Unlimited who drew in 620 people offering 1,310 suggestions. Top of their list was Green Spaces, Environment and Energy; then came Getting Around and Making Available Industrial & Business Space. The priority of Green Spaces was picked up by our Town Council who had an opportunity to seek an asset transfer of the town's greens spaces. This they did but only alongside a Planning for Real exercise where 50 organisations were represented in a church hall where they worked at generating 220 flags in maps, each indicating a specific proposal for how the green spaces could be used.

So, in 2016 we had a mandate, a truly supportive Town Council and by 2018 140 acres of the town's green spaces under our stewardship (on a 99-year lease from the County Council and via the Town Council). This was Wales' largest community asset transfer of land and brought with it our initial £1.1million of inward investment courtesy of a Lottery Award.

Building on the towns green and blue assets Open Newtown has developed a range of sustainable development initiatives including:

1. Urban Bike Park and paddle sport services. Supported by Sports Wales and the Town Council the construction on Trehafren Hill of an urban mountain bike trail and pump track. The river now has four new canoe access points to support access and enjoyment.
2. New Play Park. In partnership with the Town Council the construction of a new Town Centre playpark to form part of the gateway between the retail centre and the green spaces.
3. Riverside Venue is the flagship new community and visitor centre for the town. Relacing the dilapidated old Radio Hafren building it creates a new attraction for the town. Built to high sustainability standards it forms the gateway lining the commercial and green town centre facilities.
4. Low Carbon Transport work on two fronts:
 - a. In conjunction with communicates from Welshpool to Machynlleth we are setting up in 2021 electric vehicle car clubs to increase affordable access to transport services in our rural area.
 - b. In partnership with the County Council that will see us adding an Active Travel Bike Hub to our Riverside Venue gateway, enabling residents and visitors to better access the town and the region by bike.
5. Renewable Energy work looking to see how our town might better save energy and / or generate renewable energy, with projects emerging on housing retrofitting, biomass hub development and sustainable heat supply services to town centre buildings.

About the Where the Severn Smiles project:

During 2020 Open Newtown coordinated a pilot project called Where the Severn Smiles. Whilst disrupted by Covid-19 it laid foundations of:

- A strong partnership of organisations in the area coming together to collaborate in a way that enables our natural resources to be linked to people's wellbeing.
- A way of working that supports not-for-profit organisations.

This partnership, led by Open Newtown, has now won a 27-month project to take the learning from the pilot and develop the partnerships and natural asset services into sustainable services, now forming a part of the green recovery for Wales' economy but with the real chance of positioning Newtown as a leading community in showcasing sustainable development. This Where the Severn Smiles initiative is described as:

Bringing together new nature-based partnerships at a replicable market town scale, engaging many more people & businesses (both urban & rural) in sustainably managing their natural resources alongside piloting new models of delivery. Placing young people and their role as 'ecological observers' at the evidence-based heart of the project, underpinning understanding and awareness. Marrying this with the piloting of viable long-term solutions for green prescribing and business wellbeing / resilience and beginning to pilot ecosystem service payments with landowners.

In a little more detail, there are five workstreams:

- **Workstream 1 – Wellbeing of People in Green Spaces** through developing a Green Prescribing Service. This is formed through a partnership of Montgomeryshire Wildlife Trust, Cultivate Cooperative and Oriel Davies Gallery and builds directly on the work of the 2020 pilot in delivering a programme of wellbeing sessions to tackle health issues.
- **Workstream 2 – Wellbeing and Resilience in Business** through Nature-Based Business Resilience. This is a new partnership between Circular Economy Mid-Wales, Ponthafren Association and Robert Owen Community Banking Fund collaborating to support the towns businesses



to connect better to their environmental assets, shortening and greening supply chains, building increased resilience.

- **Workstream 3 – Sustainable Land and Livelihoods** around our town takes Open Newtown into the rural landscape around the market town with a partnership involving the Severn Rivers Trust and Robert Owen Community Banking Fund supporting farm-based work on sustainable land management and ecosystem service payment.

- **Workstream 4 – Young People leading One Planet Observatory** combines the direct employment of a youth worker within Open Newtown with the undertaking of a One Planet Audit for the town, setting a baseline for how we use our environmental assets.

- **Workstream 5 – Communicating and Events in natural resources** is a new investment for Open Newtown that will see us working on collaboration with Oriel Davies Gallery on supporting a series of town events and investing in a Communications Manager role to support the engagement of as wide an audience as possible.
